# **General Show Information and Rules**

- ASTM/SEI certified helmets with harness and boots with a heel must be worn by all riders when mounted.
- 2. Cedar Valley Stables, the Silver Moon Show Series, and show management are not responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, animals or property of any exhibitor or spectator on or off show grounds.
- 3. Management may cap entries in classes if necessary. It is highly encouraged to get entries in early to ensure you are able enter
- 4. Management may not allow post entries pending class counts
- 5. Fence heights are approximate.
- 6. Negative Coggins required, within 1 year (only need to show one time).
- 7. Derby Classes All rounds will be scored numerically, and judged on soundness, performance, hunter pace, brilliance and jumping style. The judge will invite the top 10 scores to return for a second round, run in reverse order of scores. High options will be available for an additional point added scores without major fault. Scores will be added together to determine the final placings of each derby.
  - 8. Ribbons will be rewarded in each class regardless of class size.
- 9. Horses may be ridden in multiple derbies/medals by different riders but may not be ridden by multiple riders in the same derby/medal.
- 10. Hacking will be permitted in the ring until 8am. Absolutely no jumping of any obstacles (except designated schooling jumps) will be permitted at any time, except while on course in a class. Exception for crossrail entries that may school over crossrails in the ring from 7-7:45am
- 11. Entries, counts, and results will be posted on horseshowing.com. There will be an order of go posted for most classes to keep the day moving.
- 12. The Judge's decision and Management decisions are final.
- 13. A child's riding age is the age as of Dec. 1, 2020.
- 14. Classes may be divided, combined, canceled, or re-ordered.
- 15. All scratches will still incur the office/grounds fee for that show.
- 16. No martingales shall be permitted during a flat class.
- 17. An open check or immediate payment is required to add additional classes.
- 18. To be eligible for year-end awards, riders must enter the high point program. Attendance at the year-end banquet is requested to receive your awards.
- 19. Points are awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1, with double points for the SMSS awarded on show dates indicated as double point shows.
- 20. Horse show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, add, etc. classes.
- 21. Formal attire for Derby courses is optional but encouraged if you have it!
- 22. Food / Drink will be available on-site to purchase.
- 23. Additional special awards available for those who sign up to be considered.

# **Entry Fee and Prize Money**

- 1. Payout is 1st (30%), 2nd (\$22%), 3rd (15%), 4th (12%), 5th (11%), 6th (10%)
- 2. All payouts will be mailed via check after the show is complete.

- 4. A minimum of four (4) riders are required for payout in any prizemoney awarding class. 10-rider minimum is required to receive full payouts for most Derby/Medal. If class size ranges from 4 9 riders, payout is reduced to 50%.
- 5. Jumpers must compete in the full division to be eligible for payout in the Time First Jump Off class within that division.

Open to riders 12 & under. Following the jumping round, the Judge will call back the top 10 riders to be tested in a traditional flat class, second jumping round, or in a pattern on the flat read to the riders. 10 ribbons awarded.

#### Long Stirrup Hunter Derby

Open to riders 13 & over. Top 10 in Derby to come back for second round. 10 ribbons awarded in the Derby.

#### 6. Long Stirrup Equitation Medal

Open to riders 13 & over. Following the jumping round, the Judge will call back the top 10 riders to be tested in a traditional flat class, second jumping round, or in a pattern on the flat read to the riders. 10 ribbons awarded.

Open to all horses/ponies and riders. 2' course with 2'3" high option. Top 10 in Derby to come back for second round. 10 ribbons awarded in the Derby.

#### 15. \$200 Novice Equitation Medal (2')

Open to riders who have not jumped over 2'. Following the jumping round, the Judge will call back the top 10 riders to be tested in a traditional flat class or in a pattern on the flat read to the riders. 10 ribbons awarded.

#### —RING OPEN 10-15 MIN FOR HANDWALKING OR FLATTING-

#### 16. Open Hunter on the Flat

Open to all riders on horses/ponies. Judged on way of going, soundness, and manners. May be split by horses and ponies if entries warrant. 10 ribbons awarded.

#### 17. Open Equitation on the Flat

Open to all riders on horses/ponies. Judged on the rider. May be split by age if entries warrant. Riders should be prepared for advanced commands such as sitting trot, dropping irons, etc. 10 ribbons awarded.

#### \$1000 Low Hunter Derby (2'6")

Open to all horses/ponies and riders. 2'6' course with 2'9" high option. Top 10 in Derby to come back for second round. 10 ribbons awarded in the Derby.

#### 20. \$500 Junior / Adult Equitation Medal (2'3", 2'6" and 3')

Open to riders on horses/ponies. Following the jumping round, the Judge will call back the top 10 riders to be tested in a traditional flat class, second jumping round, or in a pattern on the flat read to the riders. 10 ribbons awarded.

## \$1500 Open Hunter Derby (3')

Open to all horses/ponies and riders. 3' course with 3'3" high option. Top 10 in Derby to come back for second round. 10 ribbons awarded in the Derby

#### 23. Hunt Teams

Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Teams of three or Teams of two, shown over a course in the ring, one to follow the other at a safe hunting distance. Judged on performance, suitability, manners, uniformity, and appearance as a team. Last jump to be jumped abreast. Jumps approximately 2'3" – 2'6". Horses and/or rider may only compete on one team. To be eligible, riders must have entered/competed in at least one of the Derby Classes. Six ribbons awarded.
